Dear Parents

Many parents working as 'critical workers' may be able to ensure their child is kept at home. Every child who can be safely cared for at home should be. This is the best place for them.

That is why the government has asked parents to keep their children at home, wherever possible and asked schools to remain open only for those children who absolutely need to attend.

The fewer children in educational settings, the lower the risk that the virus can spread and infect vulnerable individuals in the wider society.

For those parents that contacted the school today requesting childcare, please be advised of the following plan.

- Children should come to school in their school uniform and bring a clean PE Kit
- From 7:30am free breakfast club is available for those who need to start work early
- Usual school hours will be in place 8:55am to 3:30pm for those not requiring breakfast club
- Care is only permitted for the days/hours the critical worker is required to work.

Please be aware that we will need to assess the demand for this provision of care on a week by week basis.

We know that some of you are under extreme pressure managing the demands of family life and balancing this with challenges of employment. You remain in our thoughts and prayers.
